## At the root of it

Lately, I've been cooking a lot! I have mostly been cooking comfort food. My comfort food. My mom's cooking. I'm going by my memory of the times I saw her cooking—from buying the ingredients to the prepping to the cooking. I don't remember all of the steps nor the ingredients, so I go by remembering what it tastes like. I know I'm not remembering all the ingredients, nor the steps, so I am gratified when it's close enough. More than anything, I think what I want to do is bring her back in my life—replaying those memories when I felt safe and taken cared of by her. Comforted by her love. Comfort food means comforted soul.

Even when more people are getting vaccinated, the future "normalcy" is not so certain. Normal gave me a routine, a pattern, I can hang my hat on, so when an unexpected thing happens, I can have the mental and emotional space to give it. Not that normal was all good. It was just that I knew what to expect. But with almost everything uncertain, I feel I'm living in the liminal space of life. And... liminal is not bad. Liminal can be good. It can invite us to suspend expectations because we don't know yet what's coming. So, we can be still and reflect on what is happening in a non-anxious way, opening ourselves up in wonder and curiosity.

The same goes for the church—the pandemic has me reflecting on the root of our relationship with God and our reason for being church. We may not come back to the same way, the same things, the same routine when we get back in full swing. But we can go by the essence and the foundation of our faith in God through one another. What needs to come back and in what way (s)? Who needs what and who can witness? At the root of it, we need God—the God who calls each one of us by name and given each one of us a part in the body of Christ. And we can do it and be together in a kind and vulnerable way. Life is too precious to behave hurtful. What if, instead of giving opinions, we can ask questions and clarify? What if, instead of being offended so quickly, we check our own feelings and give grace?

I need your help in seeking old and new ways as a faith community to be comforted by God. As well as finding ways and means in sharing God's comfort to the hurting world.

God needs you, the church, to love and serve as God loves and serves.
